



Acceptable Voter Identification

One piece of identification showing you Name and Qualifying Address (an original, or a certified or notarial copy, of a document listed below). The following chart outlines acceptable proof of identify and residence that you must bring to voting place:

- Ontario's driver licence
- Ontario Health Card (photo card)
- Ontario motor vehicle permit (vehicle portion)
- Cancelled personalized cheque
- Mortgage statement, lease or rental agreement relating to property in Ontario
- Insurance policy or insurance statement
- Loan or financial agreement with a financial institution
- Document issued or certified by court in Ontario
- An income tax assessment notice
- Child Benefit Tax statement
- Any other document from the Government of Canada, Ontario or municipality in Ontario or from an agency of such a government
- Any document from a Band Council in Ontario established under the Indian Act (Canada)
- Statement of Employment Insurance Benefits Paid T4E
- Statement of Old Age Security T4A (OAS)
- Statement of Canada Pension Plan Benefits T4A (P)
- Canada Pension Plan Statement of Contributions
- Statement of Direct Deposit for Ontario Works
- Statement of Direct Deposit for Ontario Disability Support Program
- Workplace Safety and Insurance Board Statement of Benefits T5007
- Property Tax Assessment
- Credit card statement, bank account statement, or RRSP, RRIF, or T5 Statement
- Hospital card or record
- Utility bill for hydro, water, gas, telephone or cable TV or a bill form a public utilities commission
