Funding & Financing

Ontario Trillium Fund (OTF) SEED Grant to open (Not-for-Profits)

Seed grants help organizations improve how they deliver programs and services that directly benefit community members. The grant is intended for community groups who deliver services in one of the four categories: sports and recreation, arts and culture, environment, and human and social services.

Applicants can apply for funding to carry out



projects focused on:

- organizational planning
- piloting a new program
- building their capacity to plan for future programs and services

The application period is currently open and closes August 20 at 5pm.

Rural Ontario Development (ROD) Grant

The Rural Ontario Development Program - Business Development Program is open for applications. Businesses located in rural Ontario with 1-20 employees are eligible for cost-shared funding programs.

Businesses can get up to 35% of eligible costs covered, up to \$10,000.

Eligible project types:

- Market diversification or product diversification
- Enhancing cyber security
- Succession Planning
- Accessibility

The deadline to apply is September 24, 2025 at 5:00pm.
