#### Maxville Manor Breaks Ground

A groundbreaking ceremony was hosted by Maxville Manor to celebrate achieving their \$10 Million fundraising goal. Manor staff were joined by members of Council and the Ontario Minister of Long-Term Care, Natalia Kusendova-Bashta, and MPP Stéphane Sarrazin.

Maxville Manor will be upgrading its 122 existing beds and adding 38 new beds through renovations of the existing building and an addition of two new buildings. The phased approach will bring modern amenities to support residents and staff and will include a new dining room, spa, multi-purpose room, an adult day program suite, and upgraded outdoor areas. The re-developed 160-bed home is expected to welcome additional residents in 2027.

This project will support and strengthen long-term care in the region. Thank you to the community, families, and businesses for all your fundraising efforts!

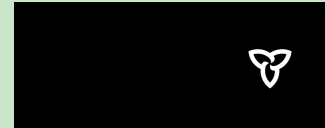


**Sustainable Canadian  
Agricultural Partnership**

The Resilient Agricultural Landscape Program (RALP), funded by the Government of Ontario, is providing additional funding through the five-year Sustainable Canadian Agriculture Partnership (SCAP).

The SCAP is a 5-year (2023-2028) \$3.5B investment by the federal, provincial, and territorial governments to strengthen competitiveness, innovation, and resiliency of Canada's agriculture, agri-food, and agri-based products sector.

The **RALP Marginal Lands Initiative** is receiving additional funding to help farmers create or enhance natural features such as wetlands or pollinator habitats on marginal agriculture lands.

Additional funds are being invested in the **RALP Ontario Agriculture Sustainability Initiative** to help farmers access funding to plant grasslands and trees, reduce tillage and build water retention features. These improvements help farmers better withstand extreme weather, improve soil and water health, and boost biodiversity.

### The Regional Tariff Response Initiative (RTRI) is now open

The RTRI is a three-year national initiative delivered by FedDev Ontario to help businesses overcome trade disruptions.

The RTRI will invest in Canadian businesses affected by trade actions by helping them improve productivity, expand and diversify markets, and strengthen supply chain and trade resilience.
